Course Description

This course strengthens students' oral expression, written expression, listening comprehension and reading comprehension in French. Regular vocabulary and grammar activities support the progressive development of accuracy, fluency and confidence.

Teaching activities are based on situations drawn from everyday life and professional contexts. The course also introduces selected aspects of French culture, including regional heritage, in order to develop both linguistic competence and intercultural awareness.

Learning Outcomes

- Communicate more confidently in French in everyday situations.
- Interact appropriately in common professional contexts.
- Improve oral expression, pronunciation and conversational fluency.
- Produce clearer and more accurate written messages and documents.
- Understand the main ideas and relevant details in spoken French.
- Read and interpret a range of practical and professional texts.
- Expand general and professional vocabulary.
- Apply essential grammatical structures with greater accuracy.
- Develop awareness of French culture and regional heritage.

Indicative Content

1. **Oral communication:** conversation, interaction and pronunciation practice.
2. **Written communication:** short texts, messages and professional documents.
3. **Listening comprehension:** authentic and adapted spoken materials.
4. **Reading comprehension:** everyday, cultural and professional texts.
5. **Vocabulary development:** recurring lexical exercises and thematic fields.
6. **Grammar consolidation:** structures required for accurate communication.
7. **Professional situations:** introductions, meetings, requests and workplace exchanges.
8. **French culture:** selected cultural references and regional heritage.

Teaching & Learning Approach

The course uses an active and communicative approach combining pair work, role plays, short presentations, listening and reading activities, guided writing, vocabulary practice and grammar review. Activities are adapted to students' needs and encourage regular participation in realistic everyday and professional situations.
